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## What is Clinical Pastoral Education?

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is interfaith professional education for spiritual caregivers. It brings students and spiritual caregivers of all faiths into supervised encounters with persons in crisis.

Out of an intense involvement with persons in need and the feedback from peers and teachers, students develop a new awareness of themselves as persons and better understand the needs of those to whom they support.

## Chaplaincy at Duke Raleigh Hospital, A Campus of Duke University Hospital

Chaplains at the Duke Raleigh campus provide a safe and confidential relationship to discuss physical, emotional, and spiritual concerns. They serve as a liaison between patients and their religious communities.
