What is Clinical Pastoral Education?

Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) is interfaith professional education for ministry. It brings theological students and ministers of all faiths into supervised encounters with persons in crisis.

Out of an intense involvement with persons in need and the feedback from peers and teachers, students develop a new awareness of themselves as persons and better understand the needs of those to whom they minister.

Chaplaincy at Duke Regional Hospital

Chaplains at Duke Regional Hospital provide a safe and confidential relationship to discuss physical, emotional and spiritual concerns. They serve as a liaison between patients and their religious communities.

Sensitive and confidential care is provided to patients of diverse religious backgrounds and spiritual preferences. In addition to patients and family members, chaplains offer supportive care to staff as necessary.
